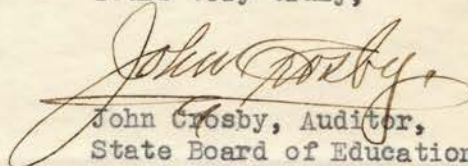
My dear Mr. Smith:
