To study production and conservation of yearly food requirements of Negro farm families in Peach, Macon, and Bulloch Counties of Georgia (1) To determine factors affecting the production and conservation of yearly food requirements and (2) To formulate recommendations and materials for use by teaching staffs in rural Negro elementary small high schools, and state teacher training institutions conducting instruction in education for production and conservation of family food requirements.
