Dear Mr. Weisiger: I am sorry to have to tell you that it has not proved possible for us to make a grant to Doctor Mizell. You know the great number of considerations that go into the selecting of a small number of grants from a great number of applications. We are holding our aid in Negro health to a small number of institutions and are unwilling to scatter our relatively small resources to the large number of workers outside this area of concentration. I am sorry to send an unfavorable reply to any suggestion from you, but I am sure you will understand the general considerations of policy which guide such decisions.
