Dear Doctor Johnson: I'm sending both you and Mr. Weaver a copy of Mr. Birkhoff's letter in regard to Jeremiah Certaine, to ask for your advice, since Mr. Embree and I are not able to decide what, if any, action is called for.

It's not, of course, a function of the Fellowship Committee, or of the director, either, to discipline erring Fellows. However, Certaine is only twenty-three; we have backed him for three years, and if there is anything we could do to help him out of this apparent personal crisis and get him back to work, I should like to do it.
