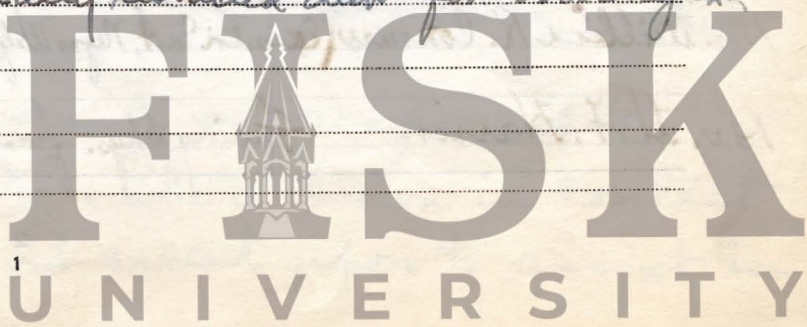

In addition to filling out the application blank, we are asking that you write an essay of not more than five hundred words, stating the major problem in your field, as you see it, and your reason for believing that additional training will enable you to help solve that problem, or, at least to make a contribution as a result of a wider experience. (Please use pages 5 and 6 for this essay.)

The major problems in the field of Public Health, as I see them are - getting people to realize the value of good health, to seek the advice of competent medical assistance in due time and to observe the simple rules of good health as cleanliness, abundance of fresh air and sunshine, proper diet and rest. Particularly is this true in tuberculosis. It is quite common to find cases of tuberculosis who have ignored the danger signals - as, a lingering cold, loss of weight and appetite, fatigue, night sweats, fever and chest pains until the disease is far advanced. Instead of seeking medical advice, they resort to various home remedies and patented medicines recommended by well meaning but, ill-informed neighbors who, "once had a similar complaint and cured them by using certain home remedies." Through the teachings and keen observance of the competent and well trained public health nurse, many early cases have been discovered and given proper medical assistance. This is also true in contagious diseases.

The nurse has quite a responsible position in the community. She is thrown in contact with various organizations and called upon to assist in

solving all human problems even to the settling of domestic affairs. It is up to her to sound the gospels and teachings of good health. She is regarded as a "life saver" and "bureau of information." For this and various other reasons, she should have the best available training in methods of handling human problems in order to do the most good.
