Dear Doctor Bousfield:

I am in receipt of your letter of October 9 in which you outlined in detail the syphilis control project for Macon County, Alabama. Since leaving Provident Hospital in the early part of 1937, I have been connected with the Civilian Conservation Corps in the capacity of Camp Surgeon, and I have always had a preference for institutional work.

This project is very interesting, and I shall be glad to have you consider me as an applicant with the proposed salary and travel expense.

At the present time I am serving at the above station as a CCC Civilian Physician. Under these circumstances it will be necessary for me to have definite information concerning my status in this proposition. Since I am already a government employee, it will take a few days to clear my property responsibility. Will it be advisable for me to begin such arrangements and can you inform me of a date to report?
