My dear Mr. Johnson: In reply to your letter of December twenty-second in which you ask for assistance to complete your work for graduation, I beg to state that unfortunately funds are not available for this purpose.

The Julius Rosenwald Fund has seldom assisted undergraduate students and at the present time scholarships are not even available in the graduate field. May I make the suggestion that you attempt to secure federal funds to assist indigent students already enrolled in colleges. I would expect your dean to be acquainted with these possibilities.

I regret very much that we are unable to give you assistance.
