(Fund's share will be one-fourth first year not to exceed \$160, one-fifth second year not to exceed \$125, and one-sixth third year not to exceed \$105).

7. In accepting aid from the Julius Rosenwald Fund—one-fourth cost first year, one-fifth second year, and one-sixth the third year, up to fixed maximums—the public school authorities agree to continue the service after the third year without further aid.

(It is understood that aid for new transportation in 1931-32 is limited to one consolidated school of four-teacher type or larger in a county, or to one high school in a county, where the school term is at least eight months and no teacher in the school receives a salary less than \$60 a month, preference to be given to new or recent consolidations where at least two years of high school work is provided and all teachers meet state or county requirements as to certification. Wherever aid is given either in the purchase or in the operation of a school transportation bus, it must be of modern type, meeting reasonable specifications for safety and comfort of pupils).
