Dear Peterson: You know something of the Philadelphia situation and how thoroughly and completely politically dominated the city is. We have been struggling for several years now to get a health center established there. Everything is now clear except the qualifications for the director. These, I am insisting, shall be at least a certificate in public health and a minimum of one years' experience. This just about narrows the field down to you. The enclosed letter indicates the state of the situation and is merely being sent to you for your own information. I urge you not to make any move at the present time which might be calculated to upset the apple cart.
