Plan centers in approximating perfection in the operation of the "Remedial Reading Clinic-Workshop," which is a functional attempt to diagnose and treat Dyslexia as found in the pre-service and in-service teachers. As it has operated, it has a dual significance, in that it serves to improve the individual reading ability of those concerned and at the same time gives training in the use of remedial reading theory which can be applied to their respective teaching situations in the parish schools, where remediation is so badly needed.
