Dear Supt. Marrs:

I take great pleasure in announcing to you that The Julius Rosenwald Fund on June 4, 1926, appropriated \$450,000, including administrative expenses, to aid in the construction of rural Negro schools and teachers' homes through the State Departments of Education in the fourteen Southern States for the year beginning July 1, 1926, and ending June 30, 1927.

The total amount for construction is \$422,000, a little less than that of last year but more than we have spent in the fourteen states for construction in any budget year. The allotment for Texas is as follows:

You will find attached a regulation made by the Trustees in response to urgent requests from the various states for aid in building County Training Schools or County High Schools striving to meet state requirements for high school standardization. While no special appropriation was made for this, each state is authorized to take the necessary amount from the regular budget appropriation.

On behalf of Mr. Rosenwald and the Trustees of The Fund I desire to thank you and your staff and through you the County Superintendents and others for the hearty co-operation in past years and hope for that same cordial relationship as we are about to begin work on the new budget year.
