Regarding Dr. Lorenzo Turner, my understanding is that his application for last year stands with preferential status among the applications of this year. There were two considerations: (1) a fellowship would fit into his present program of preparation for the South American trip more conveniently for this year than for last year, and (2) it was the feeling of the Committee that in view of certain discussions mildly involving him in connection with another situation, an award would probably come with better effect when these discussions had died down. This, however, had nothing to do with his eligibility for a fellowship on the side of his scholarship.
