You might either let me know or write direct to him.

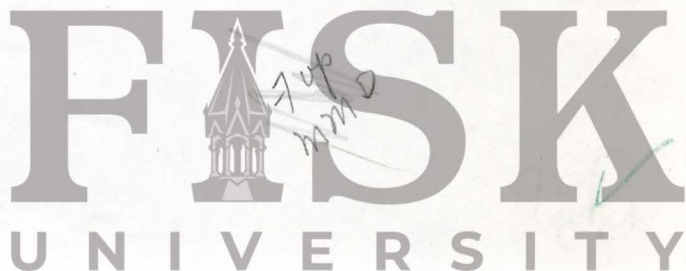
