
Dear Mr. Walker:

I am enclosing a statement of our 1943 fellowship program, which I hope you will be good enough to post and otherwise call to the attention of persons who may be especially qualified for these grants. I realize, of course, that the present emergency has reduced greatly the number of students who may be interested in or able to apply for fellowships.
