To examine the special features of anti-semitism in Germany and the Volk mythology of which it is a part. To inquire further as to the sources of its peculiar strength and appeal, and to discover its relation if any, to the antecedent German tradition. To note its parallel, if such there be, to like factors in previous history and to attempt to show why they both have arisen. It is hoped thus to contribute to an understanding of the current rise of anti-semitism so that its causes may be more adequately dealt with.
