Plan of Work:

1938 To study for Ph. D. under direction of Professor T. W. Todd at Western Reserve University, concentrating on the problems of the reproductive cycle in women.

1939 To continue above study, under supervision of Dr. Boris Rubenstein. *(see over)*
Problem changed to Sexual Maturation in Adolescent Monkeys.

Action of Fellowship Committee:

\$1,400 for one year. Renewed for \$1,000 for 1939.



Fellowships at Mount Holyoke during four years of undergraduate study, and tuition fellowship from Howard University.

Received M. S. from Howard University, June, 1938.

All work toward Ph. D. will have been completed by June of 1940. Dissertation will not be submitted until May, 1941, owing to the fact that the collection of sufficient data will require at least another six months. Problem:

"A comparative study of the vaginal smear, basal body temperature, and breast changes during the sexual cycle of white and Negro women of normal and low economic status."

Was awarded a grant of \$300 by the Brush Foundation to continue research during the summer months of study of the monkeys, and to help cover necessary expenditures for research on thesis problem.

Manuscript, "Adolescence in *Macacus rhesus*" was completed during summer of 1939.

Dr. Todd's death ended work on above problem, as hospital affiliations and necessary funds no longer available. Has been working during second fellowship on a study of the sexual maturation in adolescent monkeys. (see report with renewal application 2/19/40. Candidate for Ph. D. degree June, 1941, 9/25/40
