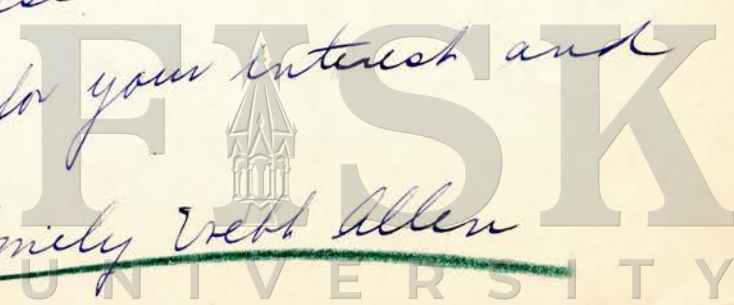
Dear Mr. Embree

I have been successful in securing a release from Tuskegee Institute beginning April 7 inst. This means that I can fulfill the years residence requirements at the University of Chicago. The Dean of Administration, here, Dr. Verbigny has recommended me for the Summer Workshop in Child Development, which will pay tuition fees for ten weeks and provide credit for a quarters work.

Through the Fund, you promised help for ten quarters work and left arrangements up to me. I hope the plan for the Spring and Fall quarters work will prove satisfactory. The summer vacation divides the quarters and I may be able to find employment to carry me until the Fall. It is necessary for me to keep my child with me which increases my responsibilities.

I am determined to find some way to make ends meet. Tuskegee Institute promises to help supplement the expenses for the workshop term but doesn't promise much because they have to replace me. Thank you for your interest and consideration.

Dear Rose: I do not think any of us need to get too much worried about the diminution of your nervous energy and efficiency. Before I had finished breakfast this morning, John Bartky called me - having probably been routed out of bed by you at the crack of dawn. At any rate, he was very cooperative. I have given him information concerning the young man, whose name is Gerald Cook, and Bartky has agreed to give him every consideration in connection with his work at Chicago Normal.

Since we have not a very good record of co-operation with you in the support of your studies, fellowships, etc., I want to go on record officially as prepared to make a grant to Mrs. Emily Allen of Tuskegee if you can work out courses that you think will be beneficial to her in connection with nursery school work and in preparation for her possible services in the general department of home economics at Tuskegee. I imagine \$900.00 will cover her needs. This is authorization for you to proceed to make arrangements for her study, up to a cost of \$900.00, which we are prepared to meet from a special fund for the development of personnel in rural education. We can arrange the details when I get back in the autumn.

Meanwhile, my thanks for your continued interest - and patience - in our educational programs.

I have promised Emily Allen of Tuskegee, to whom we gave a grant last year for development of personnel in rural education, another grant for the completion of her work toward the master's degree with Daniel A. We had helped this young woman with a view to her going back to nursery school work at Tuskegee. I do not have any very definite comments about her. If you have any direct evidence one way or another I should welcome it.



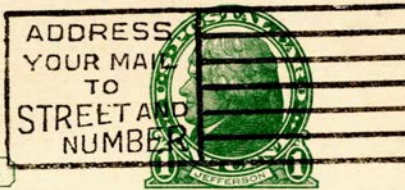
