My dear Mr. Paty:

I wish to commend to you Dr. Mark Thomas who is a member of the staff of the Atlanta Tuberculosis Association.

No doubt you have a record of Dr. Thomas in your office since he was granted an internship in 1932 at our State Sanatorium in Alto, Georgia. Dr. Thomas served under Dr. M. F. Haygood who was the superintendent at that time. Dr. W. W. Alexander, Mr. James P. Faulkner and others were interested in his placement. He is, I understand, writing you relative to an opportunity for a future study.

I am attaching our latest annual report which shows the members of medical staff serving with Dr. Thomas.

After leaving Alto Sanatorium Dr. Thomas became a member of the staff of the Atlanta Tuberculosis Association in January 1935. He has organized and taught a group of colored physicians over a period of two years. As a result you will note by comparing the attached report that our colored increase has jumped from 44 per cent to 54 per cent during the last twelve months. (If you have nothing available for Dr. Thomas at the moment I am hoping you will follow up this lead the next time you are in Atlanta.)
