Dr. J. S. Perry of Lumberton, North Carolina, was just in to see me and showed me a copy of a recent letter from Dr. J. Lloyd Thompson to you in regard to Dr. Perry's interest in psychiatry. I am writing to say that I concur in all that Dr. Thompson says about Dr. Perry and to say that he has the confidence and respect of representative people of this state. In the event that the State can provide some more definite plan for dealing with problems of mental hygiene, I believe that Dr. Perry might be very useful in such a plan, and if the Julius Rosenwald Fund could do anything in providing for his more adequate training in psychiatry, my belief is the Fund would be instrumental in rendering a most helpful service to our Negro citizens.
