Dear Mrs. Haygood:

Since your letter of October 12 reached the office I have been here only briefly between trips and my reply has been delayed. I hope this has meant no inconvenience for you.

I should like to cast my vote in favor of restoring grants to scholarship-aid students who were unable to use the grants made just before their entry into service. Although such students now have the benefits of the G.I. Bill of Rights, the stipend involved is not sufficient to cover the quality of work demanded. I do not believe the G.I. grant should enter greatly into consideration of the applicant's need. In line with this, I approve the setting aside of a small fund from the general fellowship balance to cover these cases.

I look forward to seeing you when you are here and hope nothing takes me away at that time.
