Dear Doctor Tillman: I am sending you under separate cover seven sets of blanks which are to be used in the scholarship aid program, five for your candidates, two to cover any spoilage that may occur. We are asking each candidate to fill out five separate blanks and to attach to each one a transcript of his college record, a photograph, and an essay.
