Dear Mr. Paty: I am enclosing a list of 1940 Fellows and a resolution regarding emergency appropriations by the officers. If you approve of all this, will you please sign and return the sheet for Miss Elvidge's records?

You will remember that the officers were authorized to give Mr. Still as much as possible after the other awards were made. You will, I am sure, be glad to see that we were able to renew his fellowship for the full amount requested - \$2,000. It was possible to do this from the funds released by Mr. William Henry Dean who wrote us soon after the final meeting that since it would be impossible for him to use the grant made to him last year he felt he should relinquish the \$2,500.

The total free balance, rather than the \$2,000 mentioned at the first meeting of the Committee, is, through the resolution, made available for increases in appropriations already approved by the Committee. We have already started on this by awarding Birtill Lloyd, the chemist at the University of Illinois, \$300 to enable him to complete his work during the summer.
