Dear Dr. Bousfield:

Dr. J. S. Perry of Wilmington and Lumberton, N. C. seems to be very much interested in the question of negro delinquents.

It seems that he has interviewed you and several others in regard to a fellowship for further study in the Neurological Institute in New York City. Dr. Perry seems to be seriously desirous of rendering some service to his race and I further believe that he has plenty of ambition and sincerity of purpose.

I would unhesitatingly advocate, if it is in the realm of possibility that through the Rosenwald Fund he could secure a fellowship for further study.

I have not offered him a position in North Carolina after finishing such a course. This would naturally have to be taken up with my Board for consideration and endorsement.
