Dear Mr. Weisiger: I am very much interested in your letter to Mr. Raymond Paty, concerning Dr. Mizell. If you will be good enough to set up a schedule of costs, I think we would be in a better position to consider Mizell's request.

We have, from time to time, supported residents at \$50.00 per month for training such as Dr. Mizell suggests. Under such circumstances, of course, the hospital furnishes room, board, and laundry to the resident. If this is possible at Grady, I believe that the application would be acted upon favorably here. If this is not possible then, of course, the cost rises in attempting to furnish room and board and other incidental expenses. It might make the program too expensive. I should be pleased to have you consider both types of aid and, without committing ourselves, I assure you that your request will be most carefully considered.
