I have gone over carefully the letters regarding Mr. Harry J. Greene and Mr. Martin Knowlton. My own rating of Mr. Greene's work placed him high enough to warrant prompt concurrence in the decision to extend his 1941 grant.

In the case of Martin Knowlton, Miss Smith's letter suggests an interesting character but does not picture very strongly the labor field prospects of the subject. I am willing, however, to gamble on him as a long shot in the labor field, simply because it has been so difficult to find a suitable candidate and there is a blank provision for such an interim appointment.
