My dear Clyde: I have had a great number of letters endorsing Dr. John Sinclair Perry for a scholarship. I have written Dr. Perry that we are not in a position to grant assistance to him. I regret this greatly. It does not in the least mean that his qualifications are not just as meritorious as those of some others whom we have assisted, nor that his interests are any less important. It merely means that resources for scholarships are so limited that we are not in a position to consider his request favorably.

I am sure this is a very disappointing reply, but I believe that the Fund has helped colored physicians in North Carolina in such a way as to indicate its interest.
