We are happy to amounce to you that The Julius Rosenwald Fund on March 23, 1925, appropriated \$475,630, including administrative expenses, to aid in the construction of rural schools and teachers' homes through the State Departments of Education in the fourteen Southern States for the year beginning July 1, 1925, and ending June 30, 1926.

As Mr. Reserveld authorised me to make up a budget for schoolhouse construction in the various southern states, keeping the total within the limit of \$450,000.
