In September, 1939, became professor of sociology at George Peabody College for Teachers, Nashville, at a considerably higher salary than he received in his post at Clemson College. 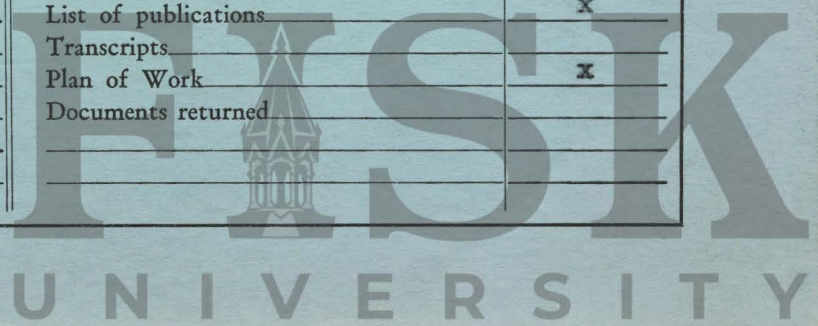
