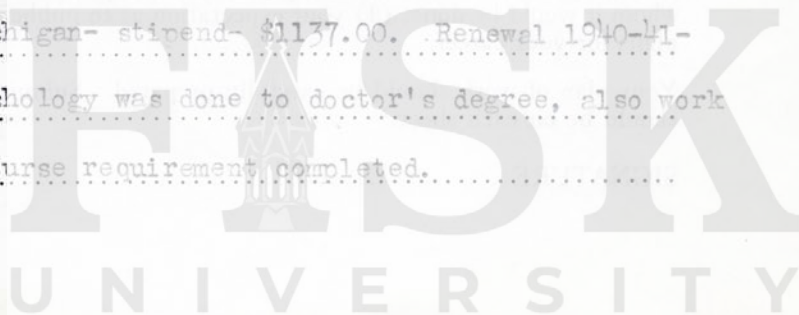

**Statement of Plan of Work**
