Dear Dr. Bousfield,

I have recently had the honor of being notified by Dean Numa P.G. Adams, and Dr. T.E. Jones that the Executive Committee of the Board of Trustees at its meeting on February 16, 1940, voted:-

"That Dr. Floarda Howard, 1100 Druid Hill Avenue, Baltimore, Md., be appointed Fellow in Surgery, full time, without compensation, beginning March 1, 1940, and automatically expiring June 30, 1940, and that he be nominated to the Secretary of the Interior for the appointment to the position of Junior Assistant Surgeon on the Attending Staff of Freedmen's Hospital, beginning March 1, 1940, and automatically expiring June 30, 1940."

Under date of February 28, the Secretary of the Interior approved the appointment as Junior Assistant Surgeon.

I understand that the training that I hope to get is of the caliber approved by the American Board of Surgery.

I do hope that you will be able to grant a stipend to enable me to continue this work after July 1, when I hope to be able to apply for continuation of above appointments.
