The more immediate purpose of this
letter is to inquire as to the worthwhileness of
considering an application for scholarship from
Dr. Ruth M. Easterling, now at Tuskegee, who
desires to carry on some work which was begun
with you in attempting to discover a "serological
diagnosis for tuberculosis before the appearance
of clinical or Roentgenological findings."
Apparently, Dr. Easterling has planned to do
this work at Howard or some other Negro institution.
I shall not reply to her letter until I have heard
from you.
