Dear Dr. Cocking: Yesterday, Mr. J. B. Calhoun, Mr. Ed. Turner, Dr. Hamon, and I went to Clarksville to complete details for the Montgomery County demonstration in school plant rehabilitation, and I am glad to tell you that the project has been approved for a total of \$1,800, to be spent over a period of three years.

The County Board of Education is to employ a full-time mechanic for twelve months in the year at a salary of around \$100 a month, and to furnish a satisfactory truck equipped with mechanics tools for use in the repair program, and in addition will provide the necessary materials for use in the repair of the school buildings and equipment, and in beautification of grounds.

This agreement is effective as of November 1, 1934. If satisfactory with you the Fund's share of the aid will be sent through your department quarterly, and checks issued by you monthly to the County. The County Superintendent will be expected to send through your office such reports as may be required, including financial statements of salary and expenses at the end of each month. It is further understood that the work will be under the general supervision of the State Department of Education.

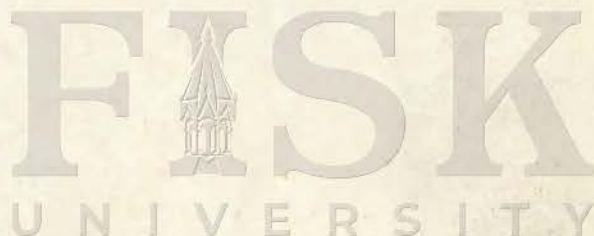
