(Any change in address should at once be communicated to the Secretary, Commonwealth Fund Fellowships.)

3. Age, giving exact date and place of birth.
(Birth certificate attached.)

4. Nationality at birth.

5. Your father's name, address, place of birth and nationality at birth.
(If father no longer living, give also name and address of person who should be informed of your movements if you are elected.)

6. Are you married?

7. **Schools.**
(a) Name your schools in order, giving addresses with dates of entering and leaving.
(b) State any position of authority you held, any distinction you attained in school work, games, school societies, &c., any university scholarship you won.
(c) Age on leaving school.



8. **University.**

- (a) Names of university and college, degree and class, with date, and other distinctions.
- (b) What were your recreations and what have been your other interests in the university?
- (c) Post-graduate career, with degrees and dates.
- (d) Publications with references.

N.B. Candidates must attach to this form a record, certified by the competent authorities, of the subjects which they have studied at the university, and of the results of their final degree examinations. In the case of members of a college within a university the certificate of the college authorities is accepted.

9. Have you at any time held a grant from the Board of Education (or from any other source) which carries an obligation to engage in teaching or other specified employment? If so how far has this obligation been discharged?

10. What will be your probable occupation on your return home?

11. Proposed course of study in the U.S.A.

Define fully the specific programme of study to be carried out. If you propose original research outline your scheme of work. While no guarantee can be given that vacancies will be available at particular universities, the assignment of Fellows to an American university will be determined primarily by the programme of study. Be as definite and concise as possible.

12. Give in order of preference the names of three Universities to which you prefer to be assigned and the reasons for this preference. Pay special attention to your second and third choices as the number of Fellows sent to any university is limited. If you wish to leave the choice of the university to the Committee of Award, this should be so stated.

13. (a) Have you entered as a candidate for any other emolument tenable in an American university?
 (b) Have you applied for or held any emolument under any body for the encouragement of research in this country?

14. Give the names and postal addresses of three referees (*not members of the Committee of Award*) from whom further information may be obtained concerning your qualifications and who have expressed their willingness to be consulted by the Committee of Award.

15. Statement of executive head of

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 College or University to the effect that your application is approved and supported by him.

16. I have read and understood the Memorandum and agree to be bound by the conditions therein stated. In the event of being appointed to a Commonwealth Fund Fellowship, I undertake not to accept another appointment until the expiration of the Fellowship, and thereon to return to Great Britain or some other part of the British Empire and to reside there for a period of not less than two years.
