

JULIUS ROSENWALD FUND SCHOLARSHIP AID

Instructions for Filing Application

Each candidate is asked to file seven typed copies of this application form with the person at his college who has charge of the Fund's scholarship-aid program.

Each of the seven forms must be accompanied by:

1. A small photograph (a good snapshot will do).
2. A transcript of the candidate's college record. One of the seven copies must be official; the others may be typewritten.
3. An essay setting forth what the candidate wishes to do during study under this grant, and describing his plans for a career. The length of this essay will be left to the candidate, but it is expected that it will be from two to five pages.
