Dear Dr. Bousfield:

I am writing in behalf of Floardo Howard, Jr. who is at present resident surgeon at Provident Hospital in Baltimore. Dr. Howard will complete three years of residence at Provident Hospital in the early autumn. During the time that he has been there he has performed about 600 major operations and assisted in about 1000.

He is very much interested in continuing his work in surgery, and desires to complete five years of special work in this connection in order to qualify before the American Board of Surgeons.

Before going to Baltimore, Dr. Howard prepared at New York University and Flower Hospital, and was for a time an interne in Harlem Hospital. He is 29 years of age and married. There are no children. His father is an Episcopal clergyman in the City of New York.


