Dear Miss Sims: Your application for scholarship has received our careful consideration. The Julius Rosenwald Fund cannot possibly act favorably upon all the requests for aid which come into the office. This has caused the Fund to specialize in a few useful and important fields, insofar as grants are made with reference to Negro health. Mainly, such aid has been given in connection with certain institutions in which we have a special interest. I regret that your application does not fall within these limits and therefore has been rejected.

I am sorry to be the medium through which such disappointing replies are so often sent. Our limited funds for Negro health leave no other recourse.
