Dear Mr. Trenholm: I am writing to inform you that this year we have discontinued our scholarship-aid program and that graduating seniors are not, therefore, eligible for aid under the fellowship program.

At the fall meeting of our Board of Trustees it was voted to discontinue this type of grant for the duration of the war. It was the consensus of opinion that we could not give the program a fair trial and make a true evaluation of the need for and results of scholarship aid in the absence of men students and in the unusual wartime employment situation. Many of the most promising students, who would in ordinary times wish to do graduate work, now feel, and I think rightly, that they should take advantage of the opportunity to obtain immediate employment.

We have given grants to some very fine young people who, I am sure, have greatly benefited under the program of the past four years, and I hope that after the war the scholarship-aid grants can be resumed.
