During his fellowship Mr. Hart met formal residence and course requirements at the University of Chicago toward his Ph. D. degree. With the aid of a small additional grant from the Fund and University scholarships, he continued his work during 1939-40, and is now doing an intensive study on the variation of mosquitoes. (He is engaged to return to head the work in biology at West Georgia College.) The mosquito study will probably be his dissertation subject. During the spring quarter of 1939-40, he will be assistant to Dr. Huff in his course in Parasitology, a position which is analogous to being a fellow in the University.

By the end of the summer quarter of 1940 he hopes to have completed all course, language and preliminary examination requirements for the Ph. D. Sept, 1939

At the end of his second year at the University of Chicago Mr. Hart completed all residence requirements for the Ph. D. degree. 9/25/40
