Dear Mr. Johnson: I am enclosing a list of 1940  
Fellows which we should like to  
have you sign and return for the Comptroller's  
records.

You will remember that the officers  
were authorized to give Mr. Still as much as possible  
after the other awards were made. You will, I am  
sure, be glad to see that we were able to renew his  
fellowship for the full amount requested, namely,  
\$2,000. It was possible to do this from the funds  
released by Mr. William Henry Dean who wrote us soon  
after the final meeting of the Committee that since  
it would be impossible for him to use the grant made  
to him last year he felt he should relinquish the  
\$2,500.

The total free balance, rather  
than \$2,000, is made available for emergency appro-  
priations up to \$500 each, according to the accompa-  
nying resolution.

Have you plans for the use of the  
photorecord for the summer? I am trying to make a  
schedule for the two machines, but do not want to  
interfere with any work that you are doing.
