Dear Mr. Wheeler: You have been recommended to Dr. Bousfield as a likely candidate for the position of laboratory technician which may be available in a new Negro hospital in Winston-Salem, North Carolina. This hospital for Negroes is being built at a cost of \$200,000, and there is the possibility that unless competent colored personnel can be found, it will be staffed with white personnel. Dr. Bousfield has requested me to ask you to write to Dr. J. B. Whittington, Superintendent of the City Memorial Hospital, telling him that you are a Negro and applying for the job of laboratory technician in this new Negro unit of the City Memorial Hospital in Winston-Salem.
