Dear Dr. Alexander: I am enclosing a list of 1940  
Fellows and a resolution regard-  
ing emergency appropriations by the officers. The total  
free balance, rather than the \$2,000 mentioned at the  
meeting of the Committee is, through the resolution,  
made available for increases in allotments already ap-  
proved by the Committee. If you approve of all this,  
will you please sign the enclosed sheet and return it  
for Miss Elvidge's records?

You will remember that the officers  
were authorized to give Mr. Still as much as possible  
after the other awards were made. You will, I am sure,  
be glad to see that we were able to renew his fellowship  
in the full amount requested - \$2,000. It was possible  
to do this from funds released by Mr. William Henry Dean  
who wrote us soon after the final meeting that since he  
could not for some time use the grant made to him last  
year for study abroad he felt he should relinquish the  
\$2,500.
