My dear Dr. Davis:

Your letter of recent date received. In reply to your request, regarding my training and experience in nursing, I wish to make the following statement:  
I am a graduate of Lincoln Hospital Training School for Nurses, New York City, Class of 1921. This is a 4-500 bed hospital which gives three years of general training in Male and Female Medical and Surgical work, General Operating Room Technique, Gynecology, Obstetrics, Pediatrics, Contagion, Social Service, Dental and X-ray Dispensary work.

Before entering training, I had three years experience as a teacher in the Public Schools of Birmingham, Ala. being a high school graduate of that city.

Since my graduation from Nurse Training School, I have done "Private Duty Nursing" in New York City

and later served as a "Charge Nurse" in Lincoln Hospital from which I graduated.

I am at the present, and for the past ten (10) years, employed as a public health nurse in Cleveland, Ohio. The health service here has a generalized program which includes Tuberculosis, Contagion, Infant Welfare, Eye, Prenatal, Venereal Diseases and School work. For the past three years, I have been taking subjects at Cleveland College & Western Reserve University, evening classes, and have also had a summer course in health work at Western Reserve University. I am registered in Ohio and New York.

I am very much interested in public health and would like to take the course, "Supervising of Public Health Nursing", at Columbia University. After completing the course, I shall work wherever I may procure a position and can do the most good.

I shall be very grateful if you will kindly inform me as to what part of the expense of the course the amount you grant, in case the scholarship is granted, will cover.

I trust this is the information which you desire.
