## FOREIGN STUDY PLAN

Trust

permits young women of intellectual interests who have completed the sophomore year with at least two years of College French or the equivalent, to continue work toward a degree at the Institut de Hautes Etudes (Villa des Fougères) in Fribourg, the heart of French Switzerland.

### Educational Advantages

The course of study aims to give students the maximum amount of French language and literature necessary for a French major, together with courses required in the junior year. Specially qualified students may, if they so desire, and with the approval of their major professor, elect studies at the University in the field of economic, education, history, history of art, mathematics, philosophy and science. They may even study a second foreign language. French however is the language spoken at the Institute.

### Expenses

Room, board, and tuition, \$1300; Steamship transportation (Cabin Class) about \$500; Optional traveling extra.

### Academic Recognition

Careful evaluation of the courses followed at the Institute or at the University is made in terms of credits. The work is directed by Rosary College, which has international recognition through its approval by the Association of American Universities.

### Cultural Advantages

In Fribourg and the environs there are many points of historic interest. Longer trips, carefully planned and made under experienced chaperonage, are scheduled for the fall, mid-winter, the spring recess, and for mid-July previous to sailing for the United States.
