Dear Dr. Sherwood: During January of 1938 I had a letter from Mr. Willard Ward Smith, then living at 1060 Oakland Avenue, Kansas City, Kansas. Smith, a colored man, was a student in the Department of Bacteriology at Kansas during the years 1935 and 1936 and apparently qualified for the position of laboratory technician in a hospital. I should like to know whether you have any information as to his present whereabouts or whether he has been placed. I should also like some word from you as to whether he is qualified to accept such a position in a grade A hospital.

It may interest you to know that I finished at Kansas two years of pre-medic work and two years of medicine in 1907. At that time McClung and Baumgardner were there.
