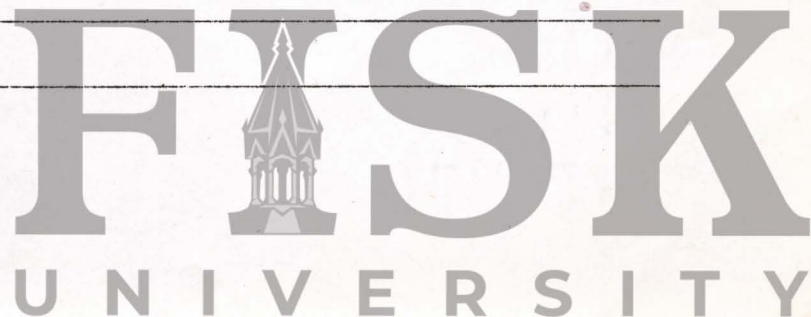

Will any time be spent in field work? If so, how much, and where? Yes. The exact

amount of time to be spent in field work can be determined more effectively after replies are received from questionnaires sent to a sample of the 2,022 southerners included in this study. It is estimated that August and September will be spent in interviewing leaders, probably in Chicago, New York, and Washington, D.C. and perhaps a few smaller cities.

Present status of work toward your degree I have completed language requirements, about two of the three years required residence time, and in the spring I will take the preliminary oral examination for the Ph.D. This will be followed in a few weeks by the written examination and I should have completed most course requirements by September or December, 1946. The residence time may require an additional term. The Ph.D. will be conferred in the June commencement 1947.
