Member of a committee appointed in the U. S. Department of Commerce in 1941 to study the problems of the Negroes in business.

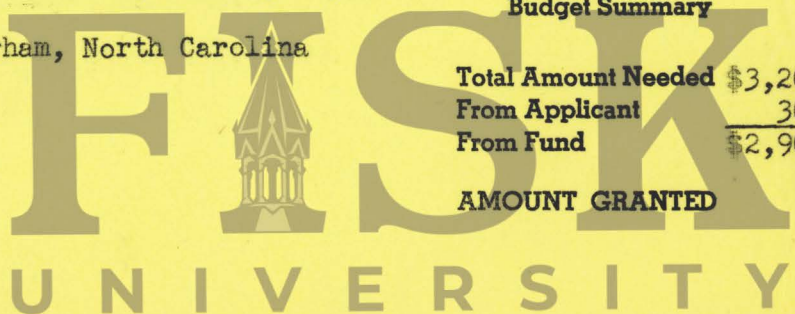
