Wherever aid is given either in the purchase or in the operation of a school transportation bus, it must be of modern type, meeting reasonable specifications for safety and comfort of pupils.)

The training of the teachers are as following:

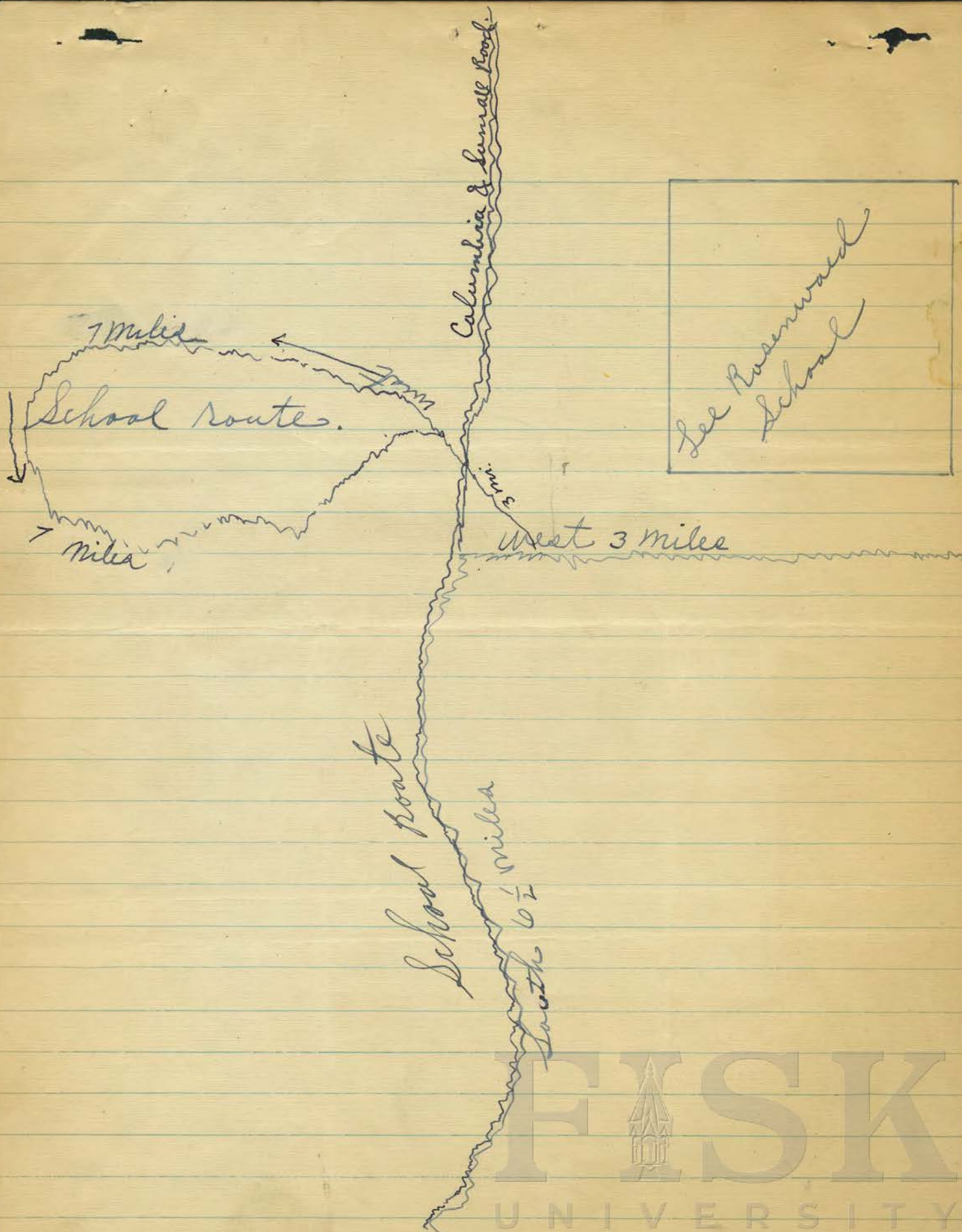
