Concise statement of plan of work. I hope to show by an analytical study of a specific instance of interracial and general intercultural working together during a crisis, that race prejudice may diminish almost to the vanishing point in a mixed group dependent for survival on its own inner resources. For three years my two young children and I were imprisoned (Philippine Islands 1942-1945) with Negro and dark skinned Oriental family groups. All normal stratifications of society were disrupted by our imprisonment: A new, cross-sectional, leadership arose. From my internment diary I hope to prepare for publication a manuscript on the leadership phase of our internment experience.

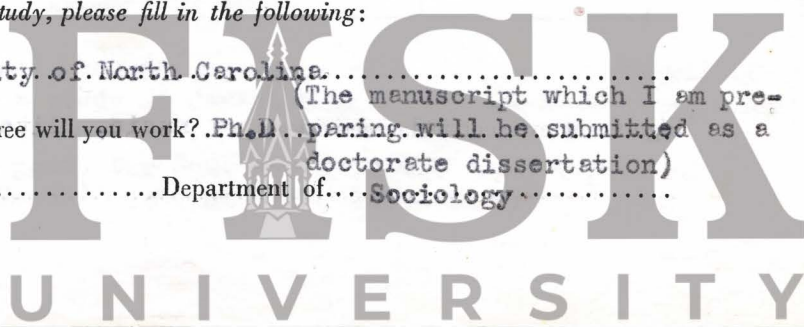

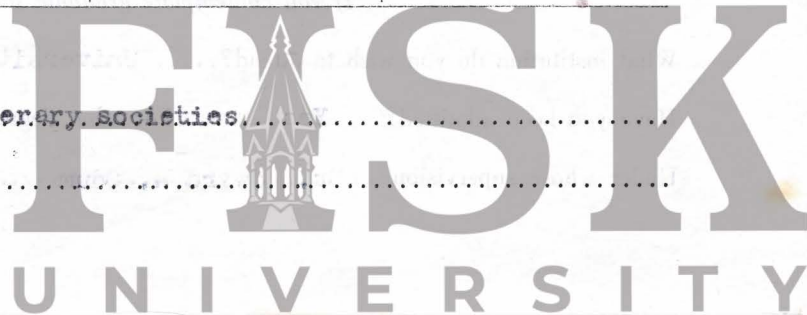
