SUBJECT: Fellowship Funds.

On March 21, I reported to you that there was \$95,506.19 available to the Committee on Fellowships for awards in 1946. Since then, \$6,400 has been reserved for additional labor scholarships, and an extension of \$375 was made to Elsie Lewis, reducing the free funds to \$88,731.19.

In addition to the above, we have ear-marked for labor scholarships, but not allocated, \$5,050; and ear-marked for the reinstatement of scholarship-aid grants to returning veterans, (but not allocated) \$1,315. S, if the Committee wanted to cancel out these special reserves, the free funds total could be increased to \$95,096.19.
