Dear Mr. Harned:

I take great pleasure in announcing to you that The Julius Rosenwald Fund on June 4, 1926, appropriated \$450,000, including administrative expenses, to aid in the construction of rural Negro schools and teachers' homes through the State Departments of Education in the fourteen Southern States for the year beginning July 1, 1926, and ending June 30, 1927.

The total amount for construction is \$422,000, a little less than that of last year but more than we have spent in the fourteen states for construction in any budget year. The allotment for Tennessee is as follows:
